BRIHUEGA REGIONAL DAY CARE CENTER

The Brihuega Regional Day Centre is located in a public building that had fallen into disuse and was in a situation of neglect. The rehabilitation and recovery of such a building in Brihuega's old town allowed it to become a Regional Day Centre, which will cover the needs of an important group in rural areas such as the elderly.

The municipality of Brihuega has 13 smaller population centres that are placed in the 300 square kilometres that encompasses its municipality, hence it is historically viewed as the neurological centre of service delivery. This influence of Brihuega also extends to many other municipalities in the region that do not have provision of services.

Due to the regional character of this project, its contribution to the improvement of public services provided in the area and the generation of employment (7 jobs, including technicians and direct care personnel), as well as its goal of avoiding the depopulation of the region (all of these objectives included in the LDS of the RDG FADETA) made Brihuega a recipient of a LEADER/CLLD AID.

INVESTMENT: 440.000 € LEADER/CLLD AID (EAFRD): 200.000 €



Furthermore, the opening of the Regional Day Care Center has led to a collaboration agreement between the Department of Social Welfare and the local Social Services for the provision from Brihuega of a permanent comprehensive public service that covers all the scopes and needs of the elderly.
