
Lack of sex-disaggregated and territorial-disagregated data makes policy design difficult

- ✓ Analysis of official statistics sources and recommendation to offer disaggregated data
- ✓ Carry out specific studies: Diagnosis of gender equality in rural areas 2021.







Labour market in rural areas still show important gender gaps



- ✓ Increase the presence of women in agriculture.
- ✓ Inclusion of the gender dimension within the CAP post 2023-2027
- End the invisible work of women in agriculture: Spanish Law of "Farms Shared Ownership".



Less participation of women in decision-making processes



- ✓ Collaboration with rural women's entities and agri-food cooperatives.
- ✓ Mentoring program aimed at rural women entrepreneurs.
- ✓ Legislative actions, e.g. Regional cooperatives legislation (f.i: Law 9/2018 of cooperatives from Extremadura): Parity in representation

Importance of giving inspiring examples



- ✓ Recognition of Project led by women by Annual Rural Women Awards.
- ✓ Rural Women Film Series
- Educational actions aimed to students







Main challenges

- Overcome the double gender and territorial gap suffered by women in rural areas
- Promote the empowerment of rural women
- Improve the availability of sex-disaggregated statistic data and territorialdisagregated data, as a key issue to make proper assessment and policies evaluation
- Improve opportunities for women in traditionally masculinised sectors, e.g. the agricultural sector
- Foster women presence in decision-making bodies
- Promote structural changes in society that allow overcoming gender stereotypes







Recommendations to move forward

- Take advantage of current CAP opportunities to address rural gender challenges.
- Include a gender perspective in other policies with an impact on rural areas: (add gender proofing to rural proofing)
- Develop legislative actions at national level that encourage structural changes, as a complement to European policies.
- Design specific systems to evaluate policies with a gender perspective.
- Promote women training in all areas and support female entrepreneurship.
- Promote collaboration between the different stakeholders. Implement public-private collaboration systems.
