Introduction

This document provides guidelines to the participants to help them organise their participation in the event. It provides relevant information about:

- Sigüenza, the rural town hosting the Forum
- the El Parador, venue of the event
- possible hotels to find accommodation
- transportation options
- field trip

Sigüenza, the rural town hosting the Forum

The High-level Rural Policy Forum is organised in El Parador of Sigüenza, a town of around 4 300 inhabitants, located in the north of the province of Guadalajara (Region of Castilla la Mancha, Spain). It is home to an outstanding architectural heritage, and in 1965 was declared a Historic-Artistic site.

The castle, the cathedral and the Plaza Mayor square are the three sights you cannot miss, although the streets of Sigüenza are full of numerous civil and religious buildings. On the 27th September at 17h00 the local authorities organise a guided visit to the town for those participants interested to get to know more about this emblematic rural town.

The castle is today a Parador hotel and will be the venue El Parador of the High-level Rural Policy Forum. The cathedral was originally built in 1130 in the Romanesque style, although it was later developed according to the Gothic canon. Its exterior resembles a mediaeval fortress, with Romanesque towers and portico and a magnificent rose window. The interior is the site of the tomb of Martín Vázquez de Arce, known as 'El Doncel' (young knight) of Sigüenza. The

Renaissance-style Plaza Mayor or market square was

urbanised in 1484-1494, and is the site of the Casas de los

Guided Tour of Sigüenza (27th September 2023)

4 Gala Dinner

The Spanish Presidency of the EU Council organises a Gala Dinner with the collaboration of the Regional LEADER Network of Castilla La Mancha (RECAMDER) at the Parador de Sigüenza, on 27th September 2023. Participants of the High-level Rural Policy Forum are kindly invited to attend the Gala Dinner. Registration will be available prior the Gala Dinner between 19h-20h.

The Gala Dinner will start at 20h00 in the Salon del Trono of the Parador de Sigüenza.



The recommended dress code for this gala dinner is dark suit (men) and cocktail dress (women).

After the Gala Dinner, RECAMDER (Castilla La Mancha Network of Local Action Groups) will offer a show in the Parador for those who want to stay.

5 El Parador, the venue of the event

The High-level Rural Policy Forum will take place in 'El Parador of Sigüenza'. It is a Medieval castle that dominates the entire town. Kings, cardinals and bishops resided in this 12th century fortress that was built over an Arab citadel. Both the interior and exterior of the castle are impressive. The cobbled courtyard, the rooms with wooden balconies, the 13th century Romanesque chapel and the vaulted dining room will take you on a journey back in time.

6 Accommodation

Participants can find accommodation in the local hotels, apartments and rural houses listed below. Note Sigüenza is a tourist destination with high demand for rooms during summer. It is the responsibility of the participants to secure their accommodation.

All confirmed participants were informed to make their accommodation arrangements by the 14th August, as rooms were blocked for this event. If you have not made your accommodation arrangements by this date, **we encourage you to make your reservation as soon as possible as the number of rooms in Sigüenza are very limited**. You could also contact other hotels and accommodations available in the area.

Finally, be aware that bookings at El Parador are all reserved for distinguished guests and speakers only, and subject to approval of the European Commission, given than the number of rooms are limited.



Please, make your room reservation as soon as possible. After the 14th August, the availability of rooms in the town is not quaranteed.

7 Transportation

7.1 Main airport

Sigüenza is 130 kilometres away from Madrid city. The organisers recommend participants from abroad, to fly to the city of Madrid (Airport Adolfo Suarez – Madrid Barajas).



To organise your flight, you can take into account the schedule of the shuttle buses to Sigüenza provided by the organisers, so you make sure you can catch one of them (see below).

7.2 Available Transport

There are several ways to get to the venue from Madrid:

- i) Shuttle buses provided by the organisers
- ii) Car rental
- iii) Public transportation.



7.2.1 Shuttle busses provided by the organisers

The following shuttle buses are available for the use of participants. Please note that the information presented here might still be subject to slight modifications:

27th September 2023

* Location for the departure from Madrid City: There will be one Shuttle bus (Shuttle 1) departing from Madrid City from The Estación de Madrid-Chamartín Clara Campoamor (see here). The bus will be located outside the station. If on the day you have any problem to get to the buses, please contact Miranda Garcia (0034 642 982 328)).







** Location for the departure from Adolfo Suarez Madrid Barajas airport: There will be three Shuttle buses departing from Adolfo Suarez Madrid Barajas airport at the Terminal de Autobuses T4 (Bus parking lot of Terminal 4). See map below and online map of the airport here.

8 Field trip (29th September)

The Spanish Presidency of the Council of the European Union with the support of the Regional LEADER Network of Castilla La Mancha (RECAMDER) organise visits to outstanding and representative projects which are driving the socio-economic development of local territory and finance by the Common Agricultural Policy and Cohesion Policy.

On the 29th of September, all participants will embark on a journey that will get them to know three of the following local initiatives:

- > Museum and beekeeping centre of Sigüenza, supported by EAFRD (more info)
- > Aromatic plants distillery of Brihuega, supported by EAFRD (more info)
- > Day Care Centre of Brihuega, supported by EAFRD (more info)
- > Rehabilitation of a textile factory (century XVII) into the Hotel Castilla Termal of Brihuega, supported by ERDF and EAFRD (more info)

Departure for the field trip by Bus is expected at <u>08h00 am</u> from Sigüenza (the location for departure will be informed to participants during the event) and will conclude with a lunch together provided by the organisers. Between 13h – 15h, RECAMDER (Castilla La Mancha Network of Local Action Groups) will offer a meal at Brihuega Royal Cloth Factory hotel to all participants attending the field visit.

At 15h, <u>all participants are brought to the Adolfo Suarez Madrid Airport and Madrid city</u> – see the tentative schedule of the shuttle bus in the previous section.
