

Access to technology appropriate


*Applications: citizenship, culture, solidarity, local production, teleworking, coworking, repair cafés, ressourceries professional flexibility, mobile fab labs/living labs, incubators/accelerators, education and training, access to technologies, circular economy, intersectoral collaboration agriculture crafts tourism*

Participative decision-making to generate commitment, shared leadership

Continuous monitoring of adaptability: experimentation, feedback, feedback

Networking and sharing of solutions recipes, rights, methods, algorithms, metadata, data, etc.

Creation of common assets, shared economies of scale




# Outlook / Recommendations

**OECD** : Virtues of third places identified in rural areas

**Europe**: third places in every country, several regional programmes and sectoral support (DG Grow, Joint Research Centre, New Bauhaus)

**France**: Agenda France Ruralité (villages of the future, smart villages guide with the role of third places).


1 Identify the third places within the business divisions and better qualify and support the production/transitions/culture/citizenship actions.

2 Recognise networks ([see France Tiers-Lieux](#)) and develop evaluation and research with them (See CASPER Citizen Activation in Shrinking rural areas for Place-based policies to Enhance Resilience).

3 Strengthen the hybrid business model by

- developing relations with public authorities
- supporting collective investment and the production of common goods
- designing a State aid exemption scheme
